Minister Damoff is committed to helping the Nawash obtain funding for other needs such as combating the Opiate Crisis, the housing shortage, having clean water and building a healthy and safe community for our

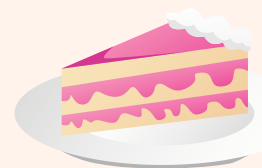

She's been instrumental in arranging a brief meeting with Minister Ahmed Hussen, of Housing, and Diversity & Inclusion, and with Minister Patty Hajdu of Indigenous Services Canada regarding the funding shortfalls on our water treatment plant so we were able to lobby for more funding recently.

The NEDAP is not a full funding program.

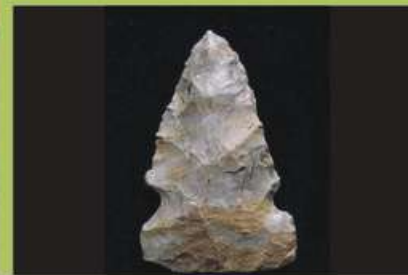
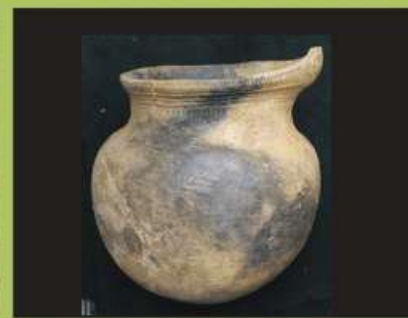
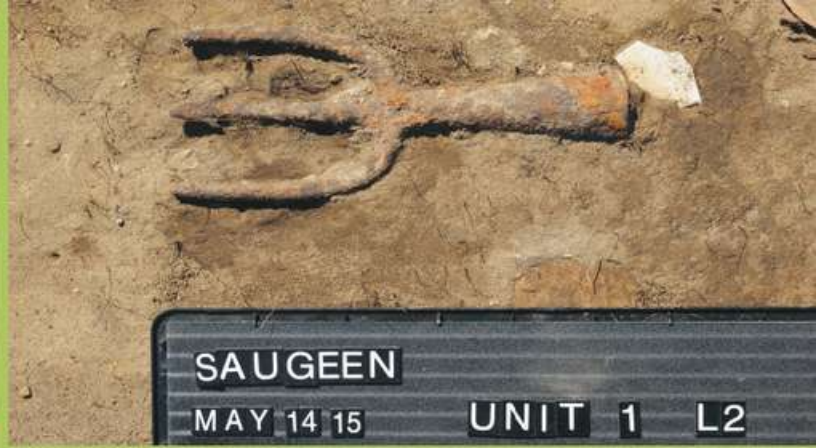
